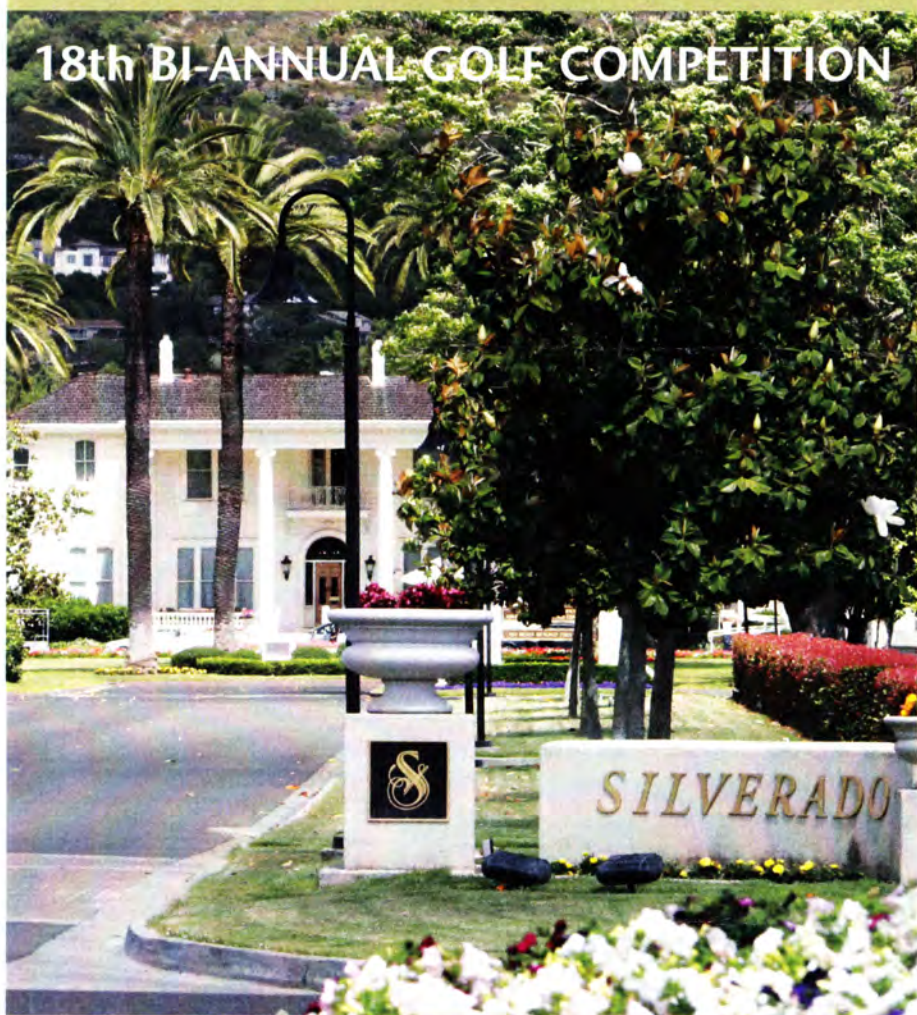

WELCOME TO SILVERADO RESORT

The SILVERADO RESORT staff is very anxious to make our stay as memorable as possible. For absolutely any needs you may have, contact the Concierge at #5386 and they will be pleased to help you with any questions or your planning. While our golf has been fully organized, and that will keep the golfers quite busy, you also may have interests in tennis, hiking, jogging, bicycling, horseback riding, pool use or any of the many Spa activities; if so please contact the Concierge for information.

The Napa Valley is filled with outstanding restaurants, but the Resort has two of its own well known eateries. **The Grill at Silverado** is open continuously daily from 6:30am, with last seating at 9:30pm. Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner are all served within certain time spans. It is known for Wine Country Cuisine with an Asian flair and seating is Casual Dress. Reservations are highly recommended. **The Royal Oak** represents Fine Dining at its best. Award winning Chef Peter Pack insists on local fresh and sustainable ingredients wherever possible. Table prepared Caesar Salad, fresh sustainable seafood and Prime Cut Angus beef are the standards in a Menu that is filled with daily specials reflecting the Chefs' ingenuity. Royal Oak Restaurant is open 4 to 9:30pm Wednesday through Sunday. Reservations are mandatory as the restaurant is popular with local traffic, in addition to the hotel guests. Dress is Resort Casual. **The Main Lounge** is open for cocktails from 11:00am to 1:00am and serves Appetizers and Hors D'oeuvres from 4:00 to 10:00pm daily. Casual Wear is allowed.

Unlike our British and Irish hotel accommodations, breakfast is not included with the room rate.

Transportation Information

Bus transportation pick-up to all day and night venues will be from the Sales Office; not the Mansion. The Sales Office is in front of the Mansion about 200 yards west. The buses will leave at the specified times so be prompt and you won't miss your ride – we will be maintaining a rigid transportation schedule due to distance traveled and timed events upon arrival. On golf days that we have 2 buses shuttling back and forth between course and hotel, please take the bus assigned to you so as not to take someone else's seat – this actually has been thought out and extra seats are limited!

WEEKS ITINERARY

Faithfully check our Bulletin Board in the Hotel Lobby each evening for daily pairings, tee times and general announcements.



SUNDAY 20 JULY

6:30 to 8:00pm Welcome Reception with Hors D'oeuvres and cocktails. Welcome comments from our two Captains as well as any important announcements for the week. Meet in the Terrace Room and please wear your Name Badge. Dress will be Casual Dress. Two drink tickets supplied for each participant with other drinks available at the cash bar.

DINNER: Please make your own arrangements and reservations are recommended – whether at the two Hotel Restaurants or off site around Napa.

MONDAY 21 JULY

SILVERADO NORTH G C for both MEN and WOMEN with tee times between 8:36 and 10:36am – WOMEN first. All golfers to receive a sleeve of logo balls with their first round. Golf with cart included.

NON-GOLFERS MEETING: Marilyn Wirth will lead a meeting at 9:30am in the TERRACE ROOM to explain planned activities and discuss the many options available in and around Napa Valley.

DINNER: Buses leave Silverado at 5:45pm for Sebastiani Winery in Sonoma where we will have a presentation, tasting, tour and dinner in the Barrel Room. Water will be available on the bus ride over. Buses return at 10pm.

TUESDAY 22 JULY

MEN and WOMEN golf at CHARDONNAY GC with tee times between 8:42 to 10:57am. First bus leaves at 7:50am – all WOMEN leave on 1st bus, in addition to MEN teeing off at 9:54 or before. 2nd bus leaves at 9am taking the remaining players. Golf complete with cart, range balls, and sleeve of Logo balls. 1st bus returns at 2:15pm and 2nd at 3:50pm. The Course has 27 holes and we will be playing the Lakes and Meadows Courses.

TEAM MEETINGS: Will take place in the NAPA HALL ROOM from 6:30 to 7:30pm. Tonight dinner is on your own and many will probably try one of the many great off site restaurants – be sure to make reservations where ever you eat. After the meeting, Gary and Marilyn Wirth are hosting a wine tasting function, featuring Rominger West Wines, off their patio for those who have made reservations with them.

WEDNESDAY 23 JULY

An Optional golf day for those that have signed up – SILVERADO SOUTH COURSE at 9, 9:08, & 9:16am. All others have a day in San Francisco. Bus leaves at 8:00am for Frank Lloyd Wrights Marin County Civic Center in San Rafael. After a 45 min guided tour we will have a few minutes for extra photos and then leave for the de Young Museum in Golden Gate Park. Here we will be lead on a private tour by Mr. David Fong AIA, of the firm Fong & Chan, who was associated with Herzog and de Meuron for the design of this acclaimed museum. We will break for lunch on our own in the Museum Café and have until 2:50 to view the Museum Collections or visit the nearby Japanese Gardens or the Conservatory of Flowers – a cast iron and glass marvel reminiscent of a white Kew Gardens. Also our ticket will be good to enter the special Chihuly Exhibit going on at that time. The bus will leave at 3pm for a short photo stop at the reconstructed Bernard Maybeck's surreal Palace of Fine Arts, built for the 1915 Panama-Pacific International Exposition. We will leave SF by a route that will afford everyone to views of Fishermans Wharf, Coit Tower, Ferry Building, Transamerica Building, B of A Building, AT & T Park, and other important structures. Having arrived in SF by The Golden Gate Bridge, we will now depart by the Bay Bridge on our way to Berkeley. After a short visit to the rehabilitated 4th St Commercial Area and an opportunity for a cold beverage, the bus will proceed to the Marina area where the Hornblower Cruise Ship awaits. The MEN golfers who opted to play golf will leave the Hotel at 6:00pm and meet us at the ship for the Cruise. We will have a GROUP PHOTO before departing on the dinner cruise. Each person will have two drink tickets each and two bottles of wine for each table of 8. Additional drinks are available at a no-host cash bar. We will view San Francisco under daylight and nightlight settings as we view both bridges from a lower angle, that earlier in the day we bused over. We'll pass around Alcatraz, Angel , and Treasure Islands during our cruise. After we dock, our buses depart for Silverado Resort at 10:10pm.

THURSDAY 24 JULY

Golfers travel to HIDDENBROOKE G C for the first day of our Golf Tournament. Busing will be by shuttle with the first bus leaving at 7:30am and the 2nd at 9am. Leave on the bus assigned to you so you don't take someone else's seat. This also allows you extra time to hit range balls, get a bite to eat, practice putting, etc. Visit the Lobby Board for bus and tee assignments. Golf complete with cart, range balls, and sleeve of Logo balls. Our tee times are 8:30 to 11:00am. Return Buses are at 2pm and 4pm. The last bus will leave sooner if all players are done and ready. The optional dinner at Kunde Winery is tonight for those who signed up and both buses leave at 5:30pm. Water will be available on the bus for the ride over. The winery and cave tour, tasting, and vineyard dinner will be led by the Winemaker, Tim Bell. Our dinner will be on top of Boot Hill, in the middle of the vineyards. All 3 Buses leave for the hotel at 9:45pm.

FRIDAY 25 JULY

Our second day of tournament golf is on Silverado South Course, with first tee times at 8:52am and the last at 10:52am. The optional Napa Valley Train ride is tonight for those who have signed up. The two buses leave the hotel at 5:00pm and leave the Depot for the hotel at 9:30pm. Dinner will be ordered on the ride and no host beverages are available on the train. Dress is casual.

SATURDAY 26 JULY

Our final day of the Tournament is today on Silverado North Course with first tee time at 8:28am and the final one at 10:28am. Our Awards Banquet is tonight with cocktails at 6:30pm in the SILVER OAK ROOM, followed by Dinner and Awards in the VINTNERS COURT at 7:30pm. In addition to the awards, the Captains will make any announcements appropriate regarding our future venue in 2010 and our Group Photo taken Wednesday on the Ship, will be handed out to each couple or single participant. The event is Black Tie optional, with Resort Dress acceptable. There will be 2 drink tickets per person at the reception and two bottles of wine at each table of 8 during dinner. A cash bar is also available from both rooms.

SUNDAY 27 JULY

This morning we say our goodbyes for a couple years and make our way towards home. Don't forget to attend to your Room Account for extra services and charges above the basic seven night \$120 per room payment.

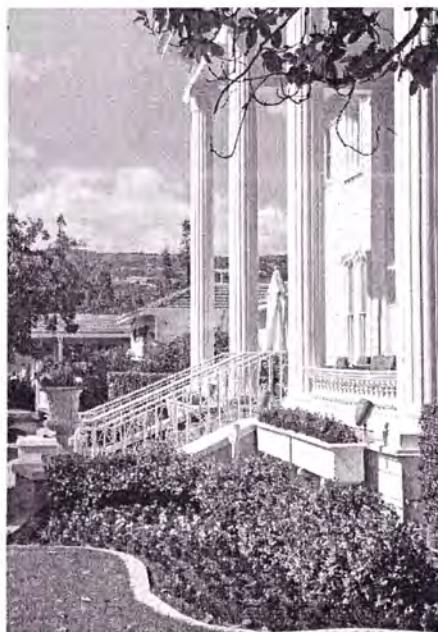
