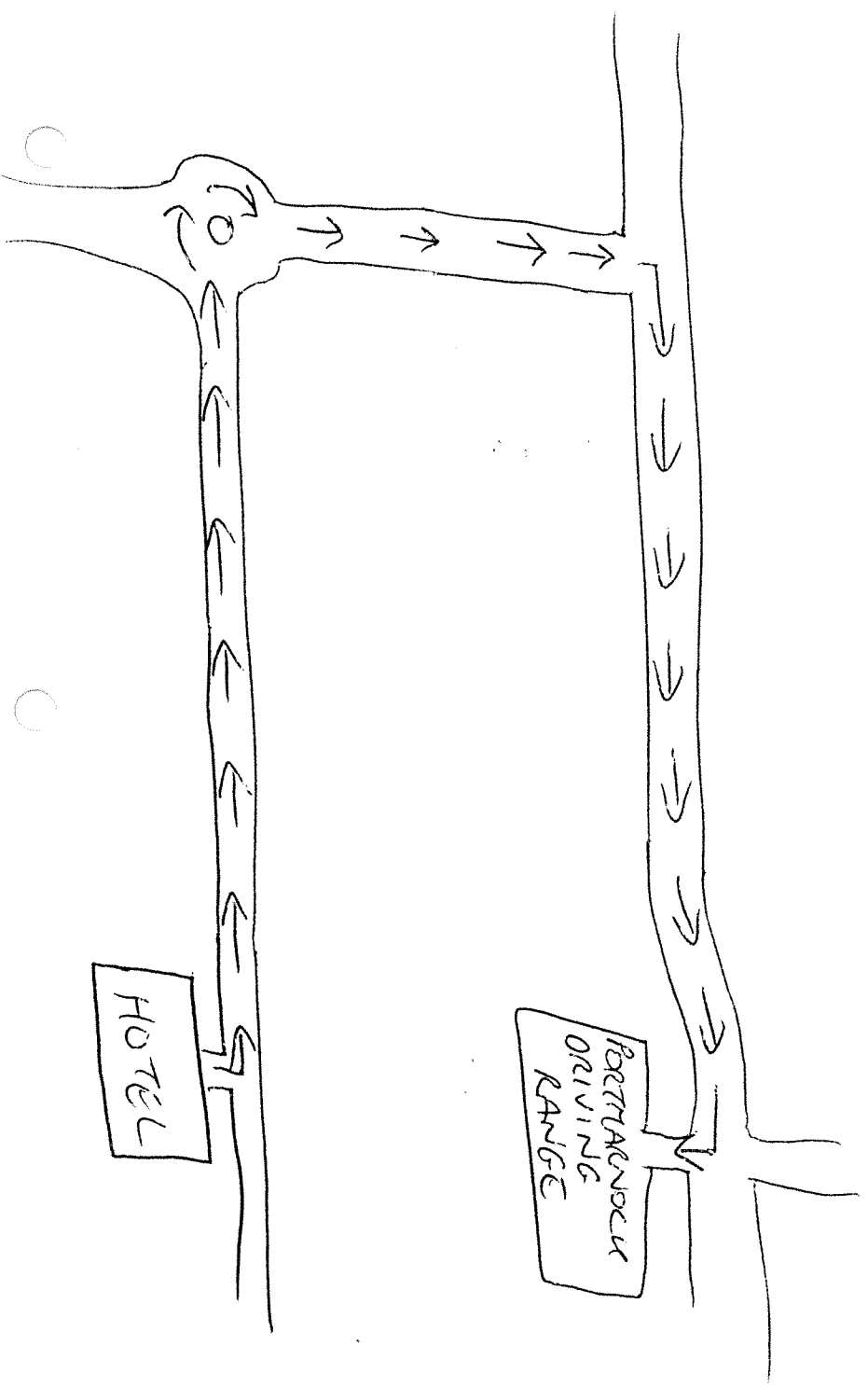

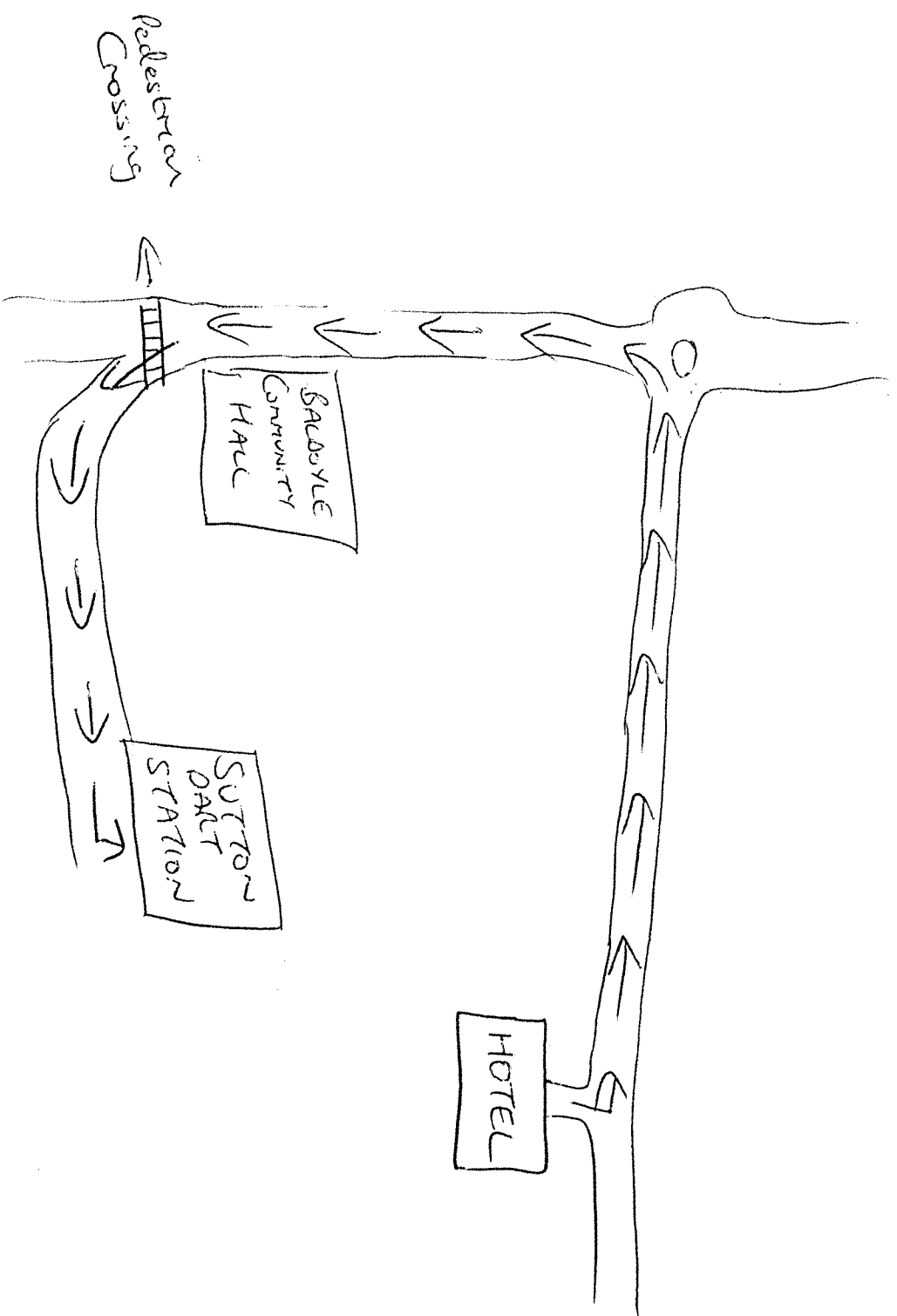

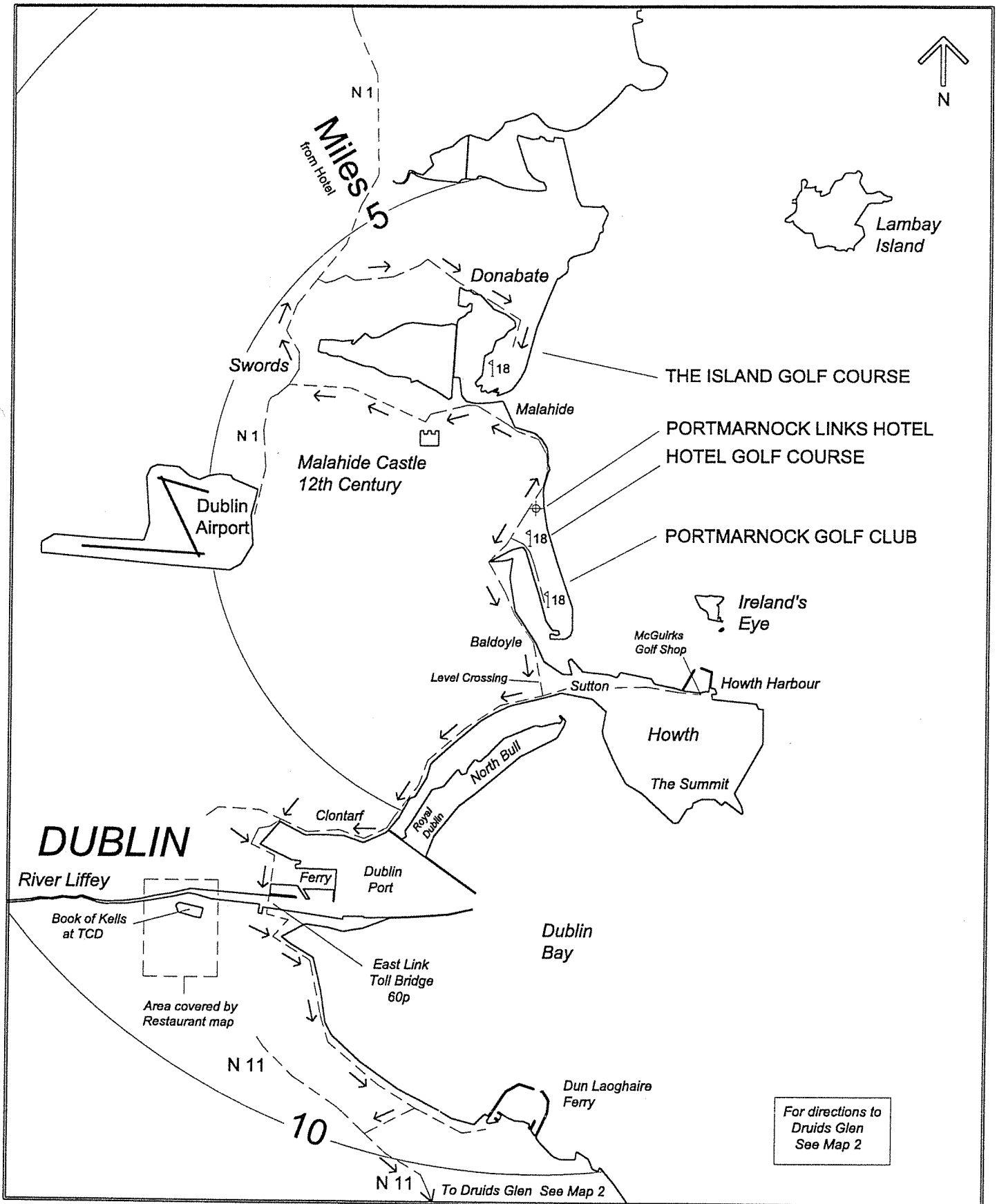

TO DRUIDS GLEN GOLF COURSE**

From Portmarnock take the coast road south to Dublin via Baldoyle and. After about 5 miles from the the railway level crossing, take the left turn (just after Clontarf and before the railway bridge) and follow the signs to the **EAST LINK TOLL BRIDGE** (60p). Then follow the signs to the **N 11**

Do not worry if you miss the first turning to the East Link Bridge, there are two others and even if you miss these, the **N 11** is signposted from the centre of Dublin.

The **N11** is signposted to Wicklow and Wexford and includes a small section of motorway. 10 miles from the end of the motorway there is a left turn to Newtown Mt Kennedy and **Druids Glen**. You need to watch out for the turning because it is easy to miss. Follow the **Druids Glen** signs (brown with squirley bits) along a very narrow twisty road. See you there.

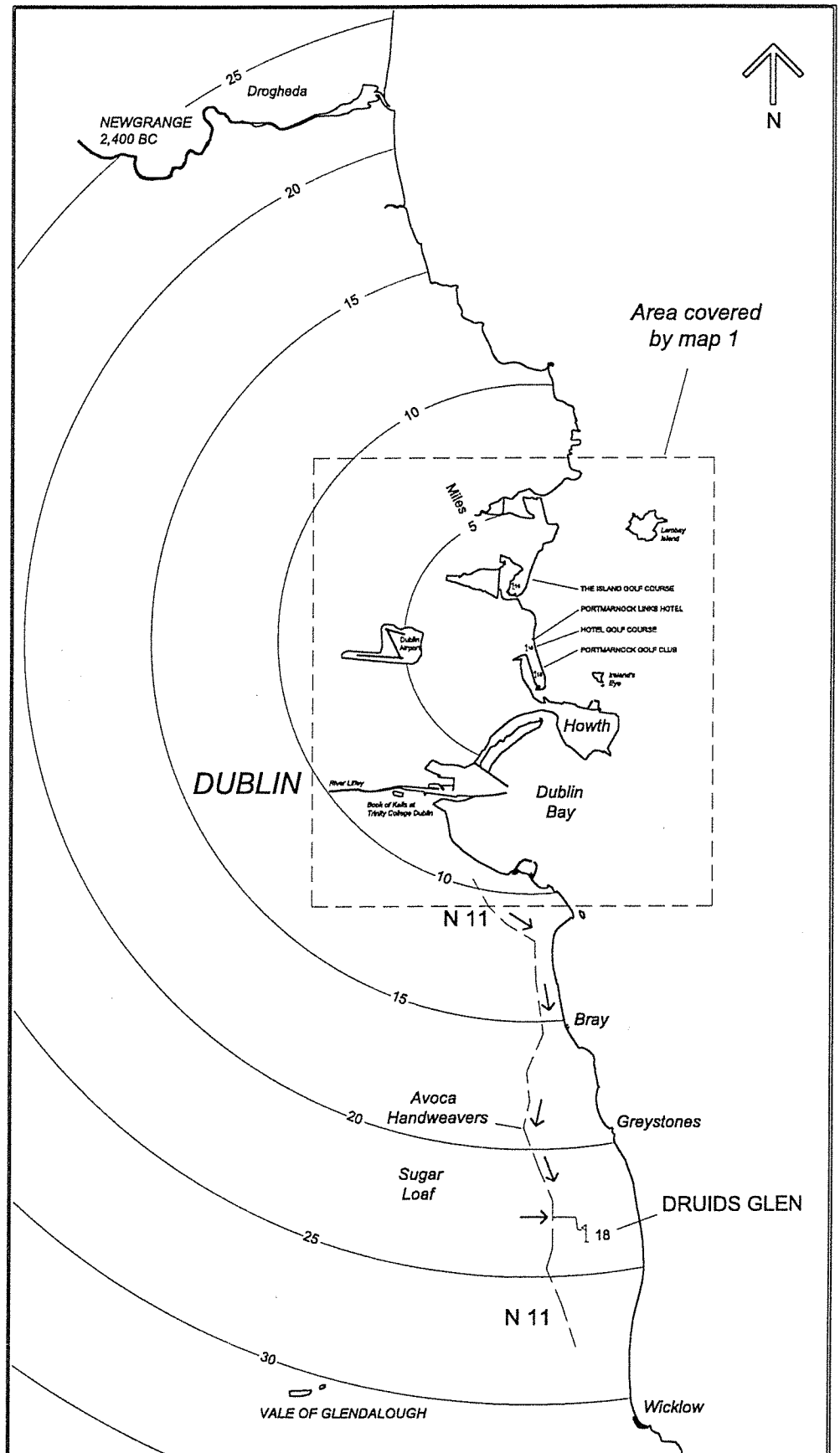
WARNING

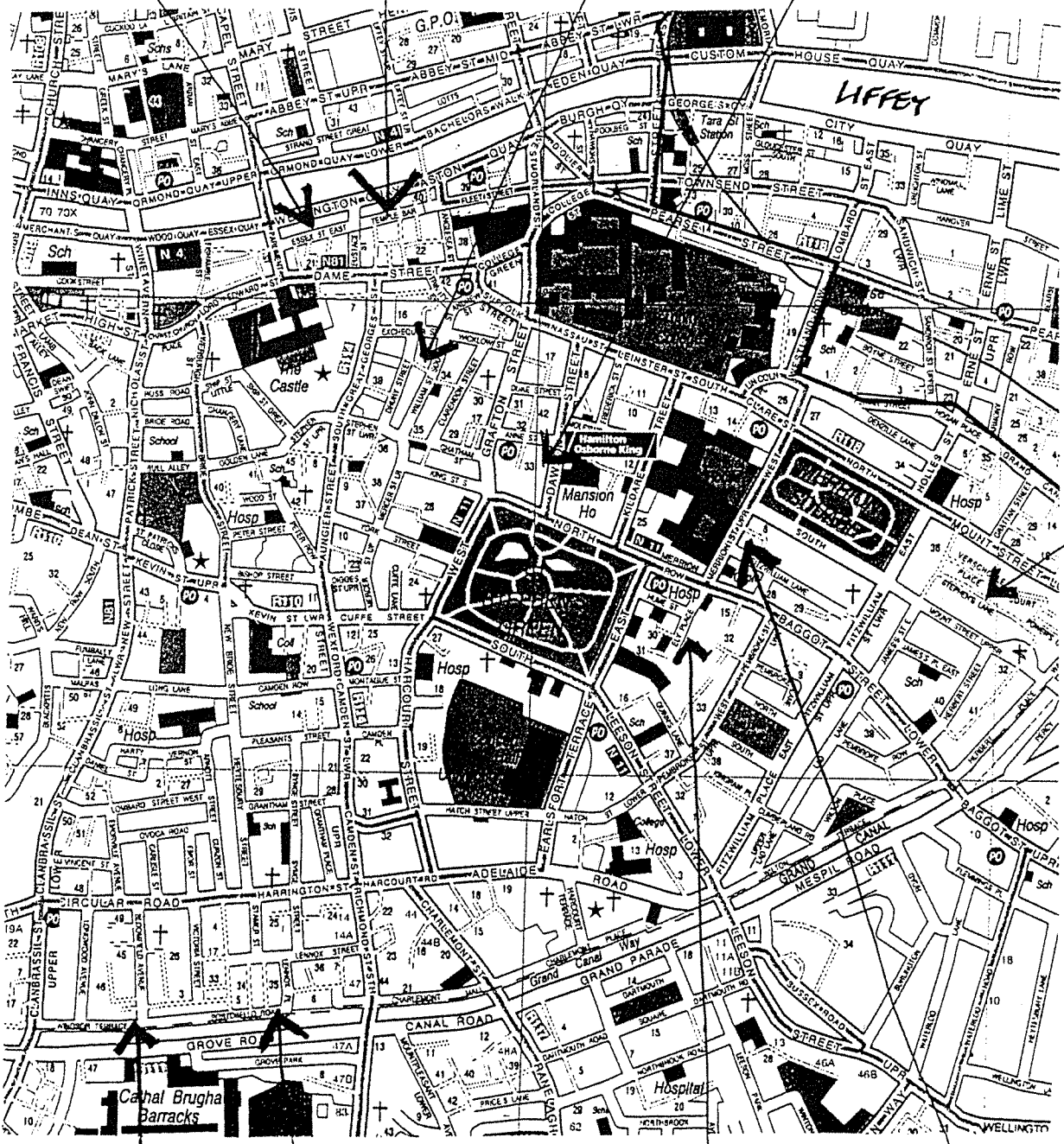
