Nearest village is **Meriden**, geographical centre of England, 2 miles from our hotel. The Bull's Head, in the centre of the village, serves traditional fare.

**Warwick**, with its huge and ancient castle, is situated about 12 miles away.

The Victorian spa town of **Leamington Spa** is also about 12 miles distant. Both of these towns have attractive streetscapes and interesting shopping.

**Stratford-upon-Avon**, home of William Shakespeare, is about 20 miles from the hotel.

A short train journey from **Coleshill Parkway station** will take you into **Birmingham**, with its major shops, art galleries and museums. Park your car at Coleshill Parkway, or arrange a taxi at reception.

The 16<sup>th</sup> century ruins of **Kenilworth Castle** are 8 miles from Meriden, and could be combined with a visit to nearby **Stoneleigh Abbey** – a large old country house.

Another possible outing could be to the National Trust properties of **Packwood House** and **Baddesley Clinton** (medieval moat house connected with the Gunpowder Plot).

The **Heritage Motor Centre** at Gaydon has the largest collection of British cars in the world (about 20 miles from Meriden).
