A short train journey from **Coleshill Parkway station** will take you into **Birmingham**, with its major shops, art galleries and museums. Park your car at Coleshill Parkway, or arrange a taxi at reception.

The 16th century ruins of **Kenilworth Castle** are 8 miles from Meriden, and could be combined with a visit to nearby **Stoneleigh Abbey** – a large old country house.

Another possible outing could be to the National Trust properties of **Packwood House** and **Baddesley Clinton** (medieval moat house connected with the Gunpowder Plot).

The **Heritage Motor Centre** at Gaydon has the largest collection of British cars in the world (about 20 miles from Meriden).
