## ITINERARY

### SUNDAY 24th JULY

CARNOUSTIE - Tee times 10 am / 10:48am - 6 minute intervals.

Allow 1 hour for travelling.

Route: take A91 north to Guard Bridge,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  miles then A919 to Tay Bridge, about 7 miles. This is a toll bridge, 20p at Dundee end. Take right-hand lane at Dundee end. Take A92 to Arbroath then branch off to A930 Broughty Ferry/Monifieth still A930. 7 miles from Broughty Ferry to Carnoustie. As you enter Carnoustie look for sign on right indicating Golf Course, turn right at sign and go under LOW bridge (remember to duck your head).

PS If when you reach the Dundee end of the Tay Bridge you have 30 minutes left before your starting time, start worrying - your late.

### MONDAY 25th JULY

OLD Course - 15 starting times 9:12am / 11:04am approximately 7 minute intervals. Allow 2 minutes for travelling.

Route: go out back door of hotel, turn right. Walk 74 metres, turn left, walk 23 metres, turn right walk 13 metres, report to caddy master D Pratt 15 minutes before your starting time if you have booked a caddy. Report to starter 10 minutes before starting time (no earlier - he does'nt like crowds on the 1st tee) usually on right hand side of first tee which is immediately in front of R & A Clubhouse i.e. the big building behind the first tee which is immediately etc etc
