These are in addition to the evening tours (for which you have already signed up). If you are interested in going to either Dover Castle, Chilham Castle Gardens or the historic town of Rye, will you indicate your preference on Sunday evening at the Cocktail Party, so that transport can be arranged.

On the golfing front, Bill Jack will Captain the British Men and Rob Walker will Captain the American team - for the ladies, Marian Jenkins Captains the British side, and Lyn Walker is the American Captain.

SATURDAY 14TH JULY

Golf: 4-ball games at Prince's Golf Club, Sandwich, tee times have been reserved commencing 10.58, with the probability of a second round later in the day for those who want one. Men, ladies or mixed games can be played - those wishing to play should advise Bill Jack so that games can be arranged.

Lunch: No lunches have been arranged, but food is available for those who wish to eat at the course.

Golf: 4-ball games at Prince's Golf Club, Sandwich. Tee times have been reserved commencing 10.58. These can be men, ladies or mixed games and a list will be compiled on Saturday on a first come first served basis. Advise Bill Jack if you wish to be included.

2-ball games can be played at <u>The Royal Cinque Ports Club</u> at Deal commencing 12 noon, fitting in with the members starting sheet. If you would prefer to play a two-ball game, advise Bill Jack who will reserve starting times and arrange pairs unless you have already done so.

Golf:

MEN playing Royal St. George's Golf Club, Sandwich commencing play 8.15 a.m. off the 10th tee for either 2 or 4 ball games. Special dispensation has been given by the Secretary for 4-ball matches to be played on the strict understanding that 2-ball games have 'right of way' and must be waved through by a 4-ball immediately.

Second round tee times have been booked - 10th tee 2 - 2.45 p.m. and from the 1st tee 2.30 - 3 p.m.

LADIES will be playing <u>Princes Golf Club</u>, Sandwich commencing 10.18 a.m. (Journey takes approximately 45 mins)

If anyone wishes to play a second round, there should be no difficulty in getting tee times later in the day.

No set arrangements have been made for lunch, but food is available for those who wish to eat at the Course.

Non Players: A visit to Dover Castle is planned. If sufficient cars are not available, taxis can be booked via the County Hotel reception. Please indicate on Sunday evening whether you would like to go on this trip, so that groups can be co-ordinated.

Evening Tour: Guided tour of Canterbury commencing 5 p.m. with official guides. The party will be split into 3 or 4 groups, each with their own guide. The meeting place for this guided tour is at Canterbury Cathedral (Christchurch Gate) - a 5 minute walk from the hotel. The tour will take approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

Practice round for both ladies and men at The Royal Cinque Ports Golf Club in Deal - commencing 9.30 a.m., (those people who are taking the London tour will tee off first). Special dispensation has been obtained to play four ball games.

No lunch arrangements have been made, but food is available for those who wish to eat at the Course.

If you are not taking the tour to London and wish to play a second round of golf, 2-ball games can be arranged in the afternoon.

Tour: Theatre trip to London and the National Theatre

Coaches leave 3 p.m. sharp from Rose Lane (closeby hotel). This trip goes via Greenwich where you board a Riverboat which will take you to the National for a light meal followed by the theatre. Coffee and biscuits will be available on the coaches.

MEN First match at <u>The Royal St. George's Club</u> Sandwich teeing off at 8.15 a.m. A light lunch is arranged at the Clubhouse.

Afternoon tee times have been booked as for Monday

10th tee - 2 p.m. - 2.45 p.m 1st tee - 2.30 - 3 p.m.

Alternatively, mixed games can be arranged for the afternoon at the nearby Prince's Golf Club.

LADIES A stableford competition has been organised for the ladies at Prince's Golf Club Sandwich commencing 9.06. As this is closeby to St. George's Club - there will be no difficulty in arranging transport jointly for men and ladies.

A light lunch has been arranged at the Clubhouse for players.

For those ladies wishing to play a second round, this is available at Prince's - either ladies or mixed.

LADIES The first ladies match will take place at The Royal Cinque Ports Club in Deal. This will be a Stableford Competition and the ladies will be following on from the men at approximately 10.30 a.m.

Golfers:

1. Green fees have not been included and payment will be required at the course on the day of play. They are as follows:-

Royal St. George's Golf Club - £40 per day

Royal Cinque Ports - £30 per day

Prince's Golf Club (Sat/Sun) - £29 per round/£31 per day

(Weekdays) - £24 per round/£26 per day

Lunches on non match days must be paid for.

- 2. It will take approximately 30 45 minutes to drive to the Golf Courses.
- 3. A time sheet will be posted in the County Hotel each evening with the order of play for the next day. Please advise Bill Jack or Rob Walker of your golf requirements.

Lady Golfers: Golf is available every day - can you advise either Marian Jenkins or Lyn Walker on Sunday evening, as to which days you are planning to play.

Non-Golfers: You will receive a pack of information giving you details of particular areas of beauty and historic interest. In addition there are suggested daytime excursions included in the itinerary which you may wish to join. Please indicate on Sunday evening if you are interested in going on any of these outings, so that arrangements can be made.

Non-players may like to make the Orchard Suite (at the County Hotel) a meeting point at say 9 a.m to make plans for the day and to share transport.
